Adult Choir – This group rehearses on Wednesday from 7:00-8:30 pm and sings at the 9:30 am Sunday Mass. Singing experience or music reading skills are not necessary! People ages 16 and older are encouraged to give it a try.

Contemporary Group: — A small, specialized group leads the congregation at the 3:00 pm Mass on Saturdays. This group combines instruments with voices, and requires an audition, along with music reading skills. Rehearsals are before Saturday Masses at 2:15 PM.

Cantor – A cantor must have some music skills, be able to consistently sing music with clarity and accuracy, and sing solo to lead the responsorial psalm. An audition is required.

Mass Ensemble – A small, vocal ensemble that leads singing at the 4:00 pm Saturday Mass. Rehearsals are held on Saturday afternoons.

Choir – This group leads the singing at the 10:00 am Sunday Mass from Labor Day through Memorial Day. Rehearsals are held on Thursday evenings at 7:00 pm. The choir warms up in the Parish Hall on Sundays at 9:15 am.

Cantores (Grades 3–5) – School choir that leads the singing at school Masses on Wednesday mornings. Rehearsals are held on Tuesday afternoons following school dismissal, 3:15-4:30 pm.

Voces (Grades 6–8) – School choir that leads the singing at school Masses on Wednesday mornings. Rehearsals are typically held on Wednesday afternoons following school dismissal, 3:15-4:30 pm. Students in PREP are welcome.

Bell Choir – The Bell Choir provides music for select Masses throughout the liturgical year, usually once a month. Rehearsals are typically held on Tuesday mornings. For additional information contact the director, Carolyn Witterstaetter at 513-941-1892.
